## HOPWA

### (Housing Opportunities for Persons Living With AIDS)

**Program Description:** The HOPWA program is for individuals who are living with HIV/AIDS and are homeless or indigent. It is designed to provide assistance in assessing each individual's needs; developing plans to achieve future goals and objectives; and locating, acquiring, financing and maintaining permanent housing.

**Length of program:** Persons may participate in our program for up to 6 months.

**Eligibility:** Individuals who declare residency in Los Angeles County, and must have a signed physician's diagnosis are eligible.

**Costs:** There is no cost for this program.

**Enrollment:** Persons may be either referred by a case management agency or apply on an individual basis.

**Availability:** Our agency currently has 8 beds available for this program.

**Foundation Description:** The Substance Abuse Foundation, founded in 1988, is the largest provider of residential and outpatient alcohol and substance abuse recovery services in the Long Beach/South Bay area. We are also the largest provider of treatment services and residential living to individuals with HIV/AIDS. Our agency serves approximately 2,000 people per year in its state licensed and certified treatment and assistance programs. The Foundation is committed to excellence in providing drug and alcohol treatment, supportive rehabilitative services and housing for those who wish to recover from their addiction and reintegrate back into the community.
