Atlantic Recovery Services provides housing and chemically-free environments to individuals referred by mental health agencies, criminal justice programs, substance abuse residential treatment programs and self-referrals. This program offers supportive services, life skills training, group & individual counseling, transportation, 12-step program, the agency provides intensive and non-intensive outpatient treatment.

Programs featured: Young Offender Reentry Program (YORP), Adult Criminal Justice Program, Probation and District Attorney's Office Programs. Eligibility: age. Fee: free for adolescents, varies for adults.

Fee: Fees are determined by sliding scale based on income and ability to pay.

Services:

- Drug Education 12 week Class \$120. A general education class covering the biological, social and psychological aspects of drug use, abuse, addiction and recovery. Locations: Health Department in English Central Facilities Center in English and Spanish
- Parenting Education 16 week class \$75. The class is designed for parents who are having family difficulties. The group is supportive of parents who are experiencing the need to make

wise choices about how to handle their children. Locations: Health Department in English; Central Facilities Center in English and Spanish.

- CARE (California Access to Recovery Effort) PROGRAM PROVIDER The Care Program will provide payment vouchers to substance abusing 12-20 year olds in Los Angeles County for treatment and recovery support services. For more info www.CaliforniaCares4youth.com or call 866-350-8773 to enroll

- PC 1000/Deferred Entry of Judgment \$512.40 sliding scale Referral by Court or Probation for 20 week program (Intake, 18 group sessions, 18 self help meetings, random drug testing and exit). Program covers the legal, physical, social and emotional aspects of drug use and abuse. Successful completion allows for court case dismissal if compliant with other probation rules. Location: Health Department in English and Spanish.

- Anger Management Adult and Youth Program \$458 sliding scale Psycho-educational group focusing on skill development, strengthening and enhancement in four basic areas: Communication, Anger Management, Stress Management and Emotional Intelligence. Certificate of Completion after 26 groups.

- City of Long Beach Drinking Driver Program State licensed DUI, Driving under the Influence, program for clients referred by court and/or DMV, Department of Motor Vehicles. Program completion satisfies administrative and/or criminal charges associated with DUI and underage alcohol offenses. Location: Health Department in English and Spanish

- Wet Reckless Programs \$155.00. A person convicted of reckless driving with a measurable amount of alcohol in their blood must complete a twelve-hour DUI education program.

- First Offender Programs \$370.00 3 months - \$560 6 months - \$810 9 months

A person convicted of a first DUI offense must complete a state-licensed three-month, 30-hour alcohol and drug education and counseling program. A person convicted of a first DUI offense with a blood alcohol content of 0.20 or higher must complete a state-licensed six-month, 45 hour alcohol and drug education and counseling program. These programs are designed to enable participants to consider attitudes and behavior, support positive lifestyle changes, and reduce or eliminate the use of alcohol and/or drugs.

- 18-Month Programs \$1362.00

Second and subsequent DUI offenders must complete an 18-month multiple offender program. Program requirements are: 52 hours of group counseling; 12 hours of alcohol and drug education; 26 self-help meetings; 6 hours of community reentry monitoring; and biweekly individual interviews during the first 12 months of the program.

Youth services- Services include alternative education; continuation high schools; crisis intervention for gang-related problems; extended day care programs for at risk youth and gang programs for children, ages 8 through 12, Family life education- Services include parenting skills development and technical assistance for youth services, Substance abuse services- Services include alcohol abuse counseling and drug abuse counseling; individual and group counseling is available. Counseling also addresses problems related to gangs and AIDS.

Eligibility: Application process, services given on a need basis (for example at risk youth would be first provided youth services). **Fee:** There are fixed fees for services; parenting skills development is \$5 per class, no fees for substance abuse services, no fee for youth services, fixed fee for youth camp.

Fee: Some programs require nominal fee, depends on whether or not client has health insurance. Health services are free to those without insurance.
