## Complete Continuum of Care

Substance Abuse Foundation provides a comprehensive "continuum of care" that includes residential and outpatient treatment, rehabilitative and supportive services, and alcohol- and drug-free housing.

Each individual's treatment program is designed to match their unique needs.

## Residential Treatment

Residential Treatment is the most intensive level of care. Men and women live in separate, private residences while they participate in daily recovery activities.

## Outpatient Treatment

Outpatient Treatment varies in intensity, according to each individual's treatment needs, from one to five or more days per week. Morning, afternoon, evening and weekend treatment services are available.

## Alcohol and Drug-Free Housing

Substance Abuse Foundation is a leader in affordable supportive housing for people who complete primary treatment and want to live in an alcohol-and-drug-free environment. One, two- and three-bedroom apartments are available for men, women and families.

## Affordable Care

Substance Abuse Foundation is a non-profit organization. Our low-cost treatment programs and services are covered by many health insurers.

Some individuals may qualify for government-funded services with a small co-payment, according to a sliding fee scale.

Some programs and services are funded, in part, by the County of Los Angeles, Department of Health Services, Alcohol and Drug Program Administration.
