Long Beach Community Services Center (part of Catholic Charities Community Services of Long Beach). Provide basic assistance with food, shelter, utilities, clothing and transportation. Case management, information and linkages to community resources.

Eligibility: Beds are available on first come first serve basis. Guests may start a line at 2:30pm Mon-Fri, and 4:30pm on Sat-Sun. All guests are breathalized upon check-in. Bring ID, but it's not necessary.

Fee: Free

Services:

- Bed sign up hours are M-F 3:00pm until full Sat-Sun: 5:00pm-untill full;
- Short/Long term shelter
- Meals: Lunch and Dinner are available to public as well as bed guests, lunch is served Mon-Fri at 12pm, gates are closed at 12pm, and dinner is at 6pm
- Showers: passes are given to male (at Samaritan house), non-bed guests at 5:30pm, 7 nights a week (Toiletries, razors, and towels are provided)
- Clothing: Given out 5 days a week, sign-ups for clothing list starts at 3:00pm and continues until 4:45pm or until full. Clothing room opens at 5:00pm and those on the list can receive the clothing
- Chapel Services: 7 days a week at 7pm, after dinner and Sunday morning at 10:30am with lunch after
- Emergency Shelter: Every guest starts here and it provides a bed for 7 days with no requirements, except that they have to show up each night and follow house rules (shower everyday, no drug or alcohol use, no disturbance)
- Case Management: Each guest can sign up for it during or immediately after their Emergency shelter stay. It lasts 90 days and depends on guest participation. Assignments are given and guests are expected to complete them or they lose their bed at the shelter
- New Life Program: 1 year long recovery/ rehabilitation. Provides holistic approach to recovery and involves activities such as work therapy, and individual and group counseling, Bible study. Interview process with the Chaplains is required to start the program.
